

## The ASEAN Quiz

### The ASEAN Interschool Youth Competition 2022 (AIYC 2022)

#### “Youth Engagement Towards SDGs in the ASEAN Community”

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#### 1. Goal of the Competition

The competition aims to raise awareness of ASEAN issues and strengthen good relations between the ASEAN +3 member countries.

#### 2. Competition Platform

The preliminary round will be run online, and the final round will be onsite.

#### 3. Date and Venue

Registration	15 <sup>th</sup> – 31 <sup>st</sup> July, 2022

Rehearsal (Online)	5 <sup>th</sup> August, 2022
Preliminary Round competition (Online)	8 <sup>th</sup> August, 2022
Announcement of the finalists	10 <sup>th</sup> August, 2022
Final Round competition (Onsite)	16 <sup>th</sup> - 19 <sup>th</sup> September, 2022

The competition consists of two levels:

##### (a) Pre-University Level (Grade 10-12 or Equivalent)

The preliminary round will be held on 8<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 from 9.00 a.m. to 12.00 a.m. (GMT+7 Bangkok).

The final round will be held on 16<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 at Prince of Songkla University, Hat Yai campus.

**(b) University Level** (Undergraduate Student)

The preliminary round will be held on 8<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 from 1.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. (GMT+7 Bangkok).

The final round will be held on 16<sup>th</sup> -19<sup>th</sup> September 2022 at Prince of Songkla University, Hat Yai campus.

**4. Requirements for Participation**

- There must be two members in each team.
- The school team members must be 10<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> graders from the same school.
- The university team members must be undergraduate students from the same university.
- Replacement of any team member is not allowed after registration.
- Participants must be nominated by their school or university.
- There is no application fee.

**5. Competition Format**

**(a) The Preliminary Round**

- The competition will be run via **Kahoot**.
- There will be 30 multiple choice questions, with four choices for each question. Each question is worth 1 point, with a total maximum score of 30 points.
- A team will have at least ten seconds to answer a question.
- The top ten highest scoring teams will qualify for the final round.
- When two team scores are tied, additional questions will be used to determine the finalist.

**(b) The Final Round**

- The competition will utilize interactive quizzes consisting of different types of questions, i.e., multiple choice, true or false, and written responses.
- Further details will be supplied later.

## 7. Other Rules

- Participants must have the Zoom software program on their device which should have a working video camera and microphone. (Online)
- Contestants should take part in the online competition with a stable internet connection for smooth audio/video conferencing, and should be physically located in a quiet place. (Online)
- Team members must all be located in the same place. (Online)
- Participants must keep their camera on during the entire competition. (Online)
- There should not be any software-generated background used in the video image so that it is easier for competition staff to monitor the participants' behavior. (Online)
- All teams must join the Zoom meeting room 15 minutes before the competition begins or they will be disqualified. (Online)
- The use of additional mobile or electronic devices is prohibited. (Online and Onsite)
- If a team fails to comply with any of the competition rules, then it will be immediately disqualified, and no prize awarded. (Online and Onsite)
- Participants may challenge a decision within a prescribed amount of time after an event, and it will be reviewed by the committee. The committee's subsequent decision is final. (Online and Onsite)
