The ASEAN Intervarsity Youth Competition 2022

“Youth Engagement Towards SDGs in the ASEAN Community”

Competition Period:

15-31 July 2022	Registration and submission of video clips
10 August 2022	Announcement of the Speech Contest finalists
16-19 September 2022	Final round of the Speech Contest

Contest Eligibility:

- Current undergraduate students nominated by their university

Description:

- The speech contest has two rounds:

First Round (held online)

- Each participant must prepare a three-minute speech on the topic of “**Youth Engagement Towards SDGs in the ASEAN Community**”. Their talk must begin with an introduction to the contestant giving their firstname, surname, university affiliation, and home country.
- **A speech shorter than 2.30 minutes or longer than 3.30 minutes will be immediately disqualified.**
- Each participant must prepare a half-body video of themselves delivering their speech. No visual aids or effects are allowed during the presentation.
- Each participant must submit their video clip as a high quality standard VDO, HD or full HD with the extension .mp4, .wmv, .mov or .avi
- The video size is 16:9 and not more than 350 MB.
- The name of the video file should be Speech-Firstname Lastname e.g. Speech-Bruce Lee.
- Each participant is responsible for the content of their speech, which must not violate copyright law.
- Participants must submit their video via the contest's registration link.
- **Ten finalists** will be shortlisted for the final round.
- The finalists will be announced on 10 August 2022.

Final Round (10 finalists)

The finalists will be given one hour to prepare a five-minute impromptu speech. At the end of each talk, the speaker must respond to questions posed by the judges for up to two minutes.

The final round will be held on 16-19 September 2022 and will take place at Prince of Songkla University, Hat Yai.

Criteria (worth a total of 100 marks)

- Organization of the speech (introduction, body, conclusion) 15 marks
- Content 40 marks
- Voice Usage 25 marks
- Appearance 15 marks
- Time Management 5 marks

Judges

The judges will be experts in several fields, including the environment, sustainability, ASEAN studies, and languages.

Prizes

Prizes are awarded as follows:

- Winner: The Dr. Thanat Khoman Award of 10,000 Baht
- First runner-up: 7,000 Baht
- The three second runner-ups: 3,000 Baht each
- All contestants will receive a certificate of participation.
